September was a little slower month for both the Bookstore and the Internet Sales group. The Bookstore sales total for September was \$817.33. This was less than last September's \$1039.65. The year-to-date total is \$8473.91 which is 87% of last September year-to-date.

The Internet Sales group is just back from their summer sales break. Their Sept. profit was \$379.00, \$802 less than last September. The year-to-date total is \$4922.00 which is slightly less than the same period last year. The combined groups' year-to-date-total is \$13395.91 which is about 10% less than last year.
